Family Life Care Center for Children & Youth Empowerment (FLC) is a faith-based nonprofit organization established to safeguard and nurture vulnerable children (abandoned, neglected and/or orphaned, within the formative years of 5 to 13).

Over 250 ethnic groups exist in Nigeria of which 62% represent two thirds of the population under the age of 25 years and 45% are under the age of 15 years. Most of this population of youths live on the streets without care and supervision, which endangers their lives and jeopardize their future.

Children rescued from the streets by FLC team, are rehabilated through the acquisition of living skills, character development and holistic education. Thereafter, reintegrated into society as catalysts of transformational change.

Every child at Family Life Care Center is given free shelter, feeding, clothing; health care and opportunities to develop their talents in sports and creative arts, from primary, secondary to tertiary level.

FLC pre-establishement charities by Oluwatoyin Alabi, spans over two decades under Integrated Catering Company Ltd (owner of the brand name - The Promise). Benefitting over 300 men, women and children in educational scholarships, grants, vocational training and welfare support across Nigeria.

The Orinaemi children, Evidence (19) and David (17), lost their father to one of the many communal crisis that trailed Rivers State, during the unrest in the Niger Delta Region. The gentleman was a pastor, dragged outside his worship center and shot dead on a cold afternoon in a community called Tombia, in 2008.

Shortly after the unfortunate incident, the widow Mrs Ruth Douglas and her children began facing daunting economic hardships. The family was soon introduced to Oluwatoyin Alabi, and the children were instantly awarded full scholarship for their primary, secondary and university education. David is currently an undergraduate studying Computer Science at the Rivers State University; while Evidence is pursuing a B.Sc in Nursing at the University of Port Harcourt. THE FOUNDER

Pst. Oluwatoyin Alabi is the President & Chief Executive Officer of Integrated Catering Company Limited, owner of the brand name *THE PROMISE*. Born at Igbaja, Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State on 10th March 1962, he had his primary school Education at Baptist Primary school, Igbaja from 1969-1975, and attended Baptist Grammar School Igbaja as well, between 1975-1980.

Pst. Oluwatoyin Alabi is a 1987 graduate of Food Science and Technology from the Federal Polytechnic, Ado-Ekiti. He is experienced and well versed in catering management with over 30 years cognate experience in the hospitality industry.

He started his Catering career with Nirvana Restaurant, Nnewi in Anambra State in July 1988 as Restaurant Manager from where he moved to Panache (Chinese / Continental) Restaurant in River Lane G. R. A. Enugu in 1990, employed as Restaurant Manager. His Experience proved relevant to the successful take off of the Genesis Restaurant in Enugu in 1991 where he worked as the pioneer Manager, and contributed to the historic opening of Genesis Restaurant Port Harcourt in November 19, 1994, where he rose to become the General Manager of the Company before he eventually disengaged voluntarily in September, 1997.

In the last quarter of 1997, he signed a Management Contract Agreement with *ALLIED THRUST* & *SYSTEM LTD* to provide Management and Technical assistance in the execution of Catering Services, Housekeeping and other Related Services for **SHELL** at its Ikang Village Guest House **SHELL Residential Area**, Port Harcourt, where he doubled as the Executive Director-Operations, and the Team Lead from 1997-1999.

By the year 2000, he decided to start his own business by registering Integrated Catering Company as an enterprise to provide catering services to corporate and high net worth individual. The company was limited by shares in February 2003 with share capital base of Ten Million.

With total commitment and determination to succeed, he opened the first outlet of the THE PROMISE Restaurant / Fast Food at 30 Aggrey Road on 27th July, 2002 and today the fortunes of the business has grown in leaps and bounds with twenty eight additional and functional outlets currently operational in Port Harcourt City, Rivers, Bayelsa and Lagos states.

The company is also a key Catering services provider for off shore operations and Remote sites of major Oil and Gas companies operating in the Niger Delta Region.

He is a distinguished Academician, with several Academic Laurels and Prizes to his credit. He won The Federal Government Talented Student Award, Ovaltine Nig. Ltd. Award, Elderson Nig. Ltd. Award, Bogs Nigeria Limited Award for being the best student in HND II Final Examination of the Department of Food Technology. THE MCF MODEL

Infrastructure and facilities for FLC free schools, charity hostels and proposed tuition free Global University of Sports and Vocational Studies shall be headquartred in Igbaja Community, Ifelodun Local Government Area, in Kwara State.

Kwara State is the 9th largest in land mass and the 6th least populous with an estimated population of about 3.2 million as at 2016. Economically, it thrives largely on agriculture, tourism and social services.

Proposed FLC campus would occupy a total land mass of approximately 10,000 hectare. Land use has been approved and some part already apportioned by the Elese of Igbaja.

FEEDING FLC STUDENTS THE FLC AGRO SUSTAINABILITY FARM PROJECT

Family Life Care Center is proposed to be self sustained through the independent FLC school to farm social enterprise initiative. Substantial acreage of farmland would be designated for the purpose within the secured FLC land mass. The vast commercial farm would supply adequate nourishment to students and personnel, whilst engaging in large scale agricultural activities including: production, processing, transporting and marketing produce for national off-takers and export.

Note that the farm would be cultivated by host community farmers whose dominant occupation is pre-established in farming. Students shall not be engaged on farm as workforce, except for practical training purposes.
